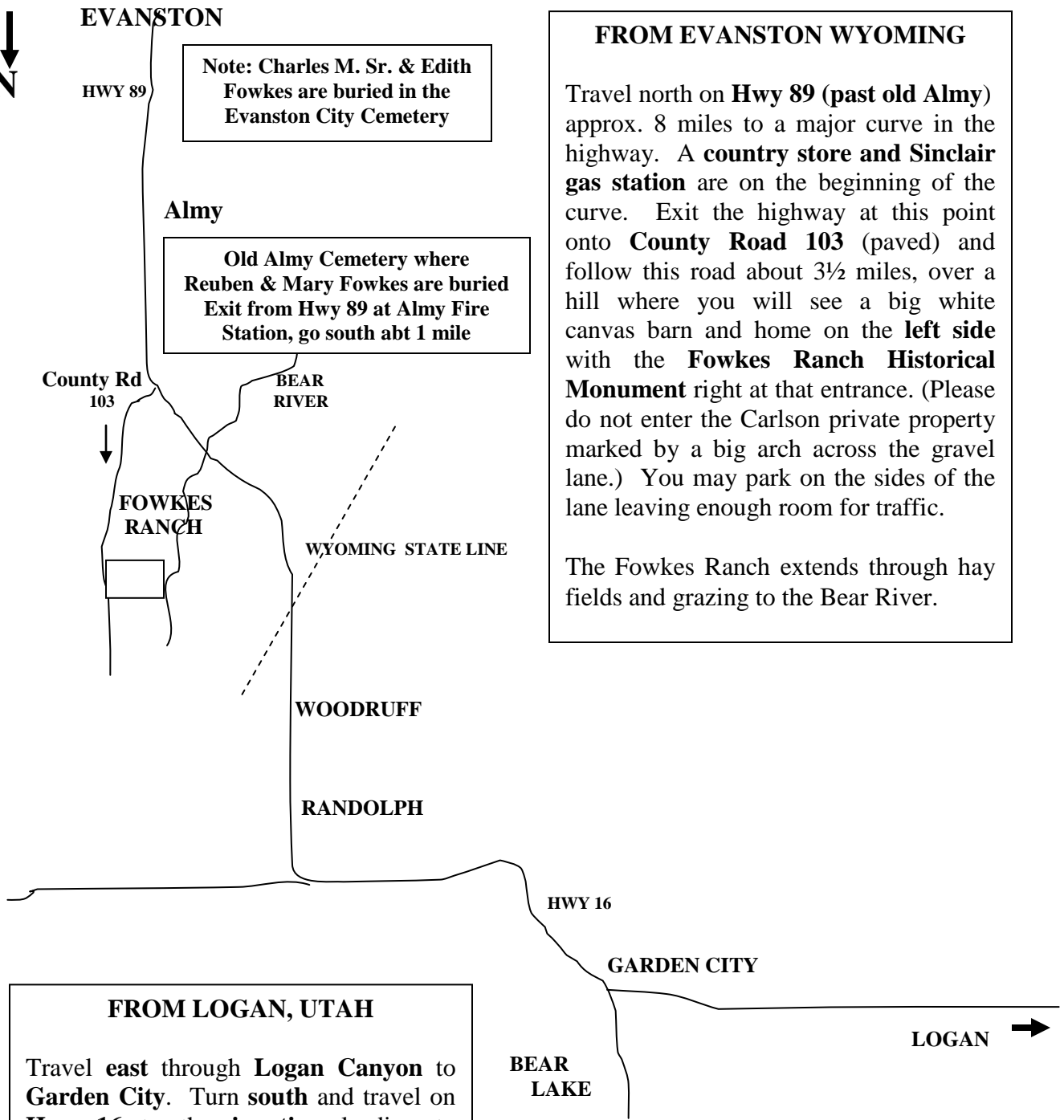


DIRECTIONS TO FOWKES RANCH



Note: Charles M. Sr. & Edith Fowkes are buried in the Evanston City Cemetery

Old Almy Cemetery where Reuben & Mary Fowkes are buried
Exit from Hwy 89 at Almy Fire Station, go south abt 1 mile

FROM EVANSTON WYOMING

Travel north on **Hwy 89 (past old Almy)** approx. 8 miles to a major curve in the highway. A **country store and Sinclair gas station** are on the beginning of the curve. Exit the highway at this point onto **County Road 103** (paved) and follow this road about 3½ miles, over a hill where you will see a big white canvas barn and home on the **left side** with the **Fowkes Ranch Historical Monument** right at that entrance. (Please do not enter the Carlson private property marked by a big arch across the gravel lane.) You may park on the sides of the lane leaving enough room for traffic.

The Fowkes Ranch extends through hay fields and grazing to the Bear River.

FROM LOGAN, UTAH

Travel east through **Logan Canyon** to **Garden City**. Turn **south** and travel on **Hwy 16** to the **junction** leading to **Randolph and Woodruff, Utah**. Pass the **Wyoming State Line** and **cross the Bear River Bridge** to the east side of the valley. Upon reaching the country store and **Sinclair gas station** mentioned in the Evanston directions, turn **north** onto **County Road 103** (see map) and follow the Evanston directions to the **Fowkes Ranch**.
